THE DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE.

The report of the secretary stated that there is a prospect that the pollution of the Thames at London, which some years ago required action on the part of the city, will shortly be remedied by the construction of a trunk sewer, the disposal of the sewage on a sewage farm some distance from the city, and by the extension of the general sewerage system of the city, with an intercepting sewer by which the sewage from the main trunk sewer will be conducted to the main trunk sewer.
