scrupulous contractors, Fratelli amd Moroni, is the beginning of the end. Several of the great financial institutions are implicated in the failure, and the consequences are likely enough to be disastrous to the Italian Government as well as to the individuals who have entrusted their savings to the dishonest speculators of the "New Rome." Fortunately, the builders have huilded better than they knew, and, in several instances, the unsightly structures have been hardly completed before they toppled over, as if their mean and squalid existence was impossible in presence of the awful shadow of the Vatican and St. Peter's .- Freeman's Journal, N. Y.


