

from their sales. C. & Co. upon quitting business told A. & Co. they could not pay until sixty or ninety days, in which they could make collections from their sales, and A. & Co. thereupon accepted their notes, payable in that time for the amount owing by them. Upon this state of facts the Kentucky Court of Appeals held (Emerson *et al.* vs. Dye *et al.*) that the parties to the guaranty must have understood that the exact time of payment was thereafter to be fixed by the creditor and principal debtor, which was done by the execution of the notes, that there was no default by the principal until the notes matured, and that therefore the execution of the notes without the guarantor's consent did not release him.

TELEPHONE COMPANIES—DUTIES TO PUBLIC.
In the case of State vs. Nebraska Telephone Company, decided on the 21st January, the Supreme Court of Nebraska held that telephone companies are common carriers of news; that all persons are entitled to equal facilities in the employment of the benefits to be derived from the use of the telephone, and that where no good reason is assigned for a refusal of a telephone company to furnish a telephone instrument to a person desiring to become a subscriber and tendering a full compliance with all the rules established for other subscribers, a writ of mandamus should be issued to compel such company to furnish such person with the necessary instruments. In giving judgment in the case the court said: "The demands of the commerce of the present day make the telephone a necessity. All people, upon complying with the reasonable rules and demands of the commodity, patented as it is, should have the benefits of the new commerce."—*Bradstreet's*.
