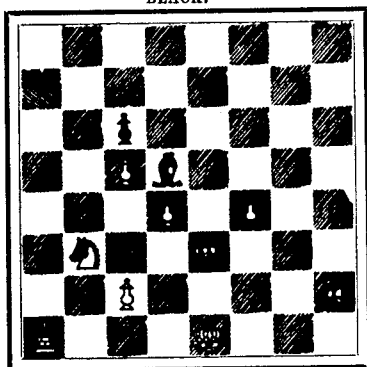


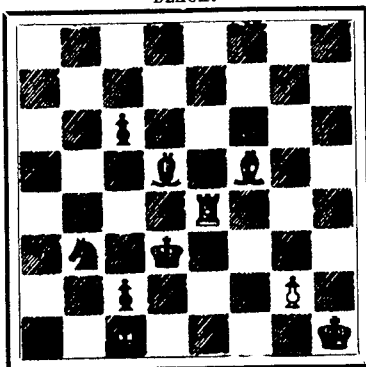

A LONG-PROTRACTED CHESS MATCH.—Following is the result of the second International Correspondence Chess Match, beginning November 1, 1888, between the United States and Canada, sixty players on each side: Canada, games won, 16; drawn, 7½; total, 23½. United States, games won, 29; drawn, 7½; total, 36½. Grand total, 60. The game between Mr. W. Neish, of Kingston, and C. O. Wilcox, of New Orleans, has been decided a draw. The latter is a member of the New Orleans club, with a limited membership of seven hundred, and was the winner of last year's tourney. Mr. Neish won the two games played in the first international match some years ago, his opponent then being a chess editor.

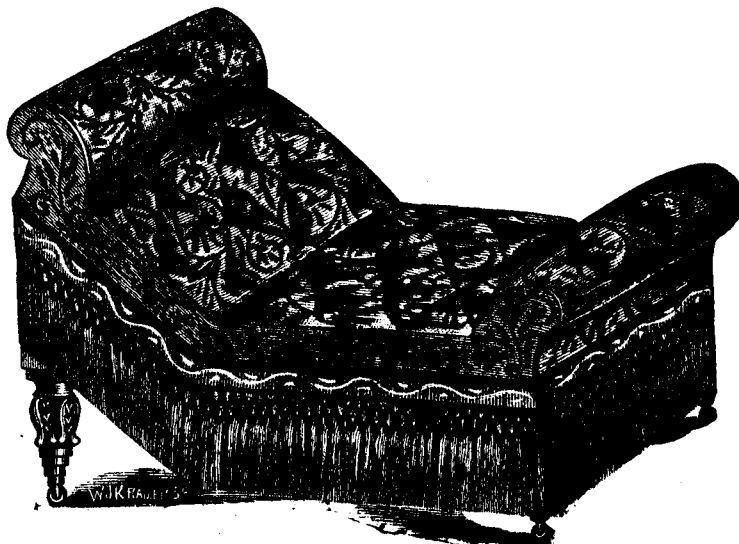
