# PART II

# PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE APPLICABLE LEGISLATION

#### ARTICLE VI

### General Rule

Subject to Articles VII to X, a person who is engaged in a gainful activity in the territory of a Contracting Party shall, in respect of that activity, be subject only to the legislation of that Contracting Party.

#### ARTICLE VII

#### Detachments

- If a person who is subject to the legislation of a Contracting Party and who is
  employed by an employer having a place of business in the territory of that
  Contracting Party is sent, in the course of that employment, to work in the
  territory of the other Contracting Party, that person shall, in respect of that work,
  be subject only to the legislation of the first Contracting Party as though that work
  was performed in its territory.
- Paragraph 1 shall not apply to a detachment of more than 60 months without the prior consent of the competent authorities of both Contracting Parties or their delegated institutions or agencies.

#### ARTICLE VIII

## Self-employment

Article VII(1) shall apply, by analogy, to a self-employed person who ordinarily
resides in the territory of a Contracting Party and who carries out self-employed
activities in the territory of the other Contracting Party.
