I must apologise for not having replied before to your letter of June 3rd in regard to the Professorship of Education in McGill. It reached me just before I went west to attend the Conference of Canadian Universities in Winnipeg, and at that time the whole situation was so uncertain that I was not in a position to say anything definite, nor can I do so now except to inform you that it has been decided to defer the appointment till next year. During the coming session we shall continue the temperary arrangements that we had last year.
