notify the Secretary thereof, and pay the subscription for the then current year; and failing so to do, his name shall be struck from the roll of members, unless some good excuse be offered to the Committee to account for his neglect.

Aur. 12 .- Officers in Her Majesty's army &c., Army and Navy, and persons holding military and civil appointments under the Imperial Government, who may be stationed in Canada for an indefinite period, and subject to be terminated by the occurrence of circumstances beyond their control, and clergymen, shall be eligible for election as members, without payment of entrance fee, but subject to the payment of an annual subscription of \$20, or a semi-annual subscription of \$10; Provided always, that any such officer shall have the privilege of using the Club for the term of 30 days, upon payment of \$5, if he has left Ottawa er is quartered in any other part of British North America, and provided also that officers of Her Majesty's army and navy and that persons not resident in Canada, may be introduced by two of the Executive Committee as Honorary Members and be thereupon entitled to all the rights of Privileged Members for a period not exceeding ten days : but any such Honorary Members shall not be eligible at the expiration of that period to be again placed on the list of honorary members until after an interval of three months, the names of such honorary members to be posted in the Coffee Room and number of such admissions at any one time to be decided by the Committee.
