HUNGARIAN WOMAN FIRES AT AMBROUS BOARDER

Locked Up on Charge of Shooting With Intent to Kill—Minor Mention.

HAMILTON, Dec. 16.—There was another shooting affray this afternoon amongst foreigners, and Kata Kataragin, an Austrian woman, who keeps a boarding house at 405 North-Hughson-street, was locked up on the charge of shooting at Hurnash Gaskbavitch, a boarder, with intent to kill. The boarder secured the warrant. When he appeared at police headquarters he displayed two bullet holes in his clothing. One bullet grazed his shoulder and another his side. The side of his face was blackened with powder. The woman cannot speak English, but when an interpreter was secured she told him that the boarder had attempted to assault her in the absence of her husband and the shooting was done in self-defence while she was struggling with her assailant.
