TRAGIC DEATH OF YOUNG NAPINKA MARRIED WOMAN

Cup of Coal Oil Exploded and Clothing Burst Into Flames—Former Seaforth Girl.

NAPINKA, Man., Dec. 29.—(Special).—Mrs. John Yeomans, wife of John Yeomans, one of Medora's most promising young farmers, died this morning from the result of injuries received from the explosion of a cup of coal oil. Mr. Yeomans, before going out to do the chores, lighted a fire in the kitchen range, leaving a cup of coal oil, part of which he had used to light the fire, upon the top of the range.

Mrs. Yeomans was in the act of dressing beside the range, when, without any warning, there was an explosion. In an instant, she was covered with a mass of flames, and before help could be secured was so badly burned that very little hope could be held out for her recovery.
