OVER HALF EXAMINED Ratio of Applications for Exemption is Ten to One. It is estimated by the military authorities in Toronto and the districts nearby that 80,000 men subject to the present call of the Military Service Act. Up to yesterday 15,897 of them had applied for examination at a number of applicants is looked for during this week.

Official figures issued last night by the Ontario registrar's office show that 22,829 men have been behind the lines in military districts have filed claims for exemption from military service, and 2189 have reported as ready to serve. Exemptions totaled 1828 and reports 148.

One hundred and one recruits for military service were enrolled yesterday at the Toronto mobilization center, 48 joining the C. E. F. and 53 the Royal Flying Corps. Those enrolling with the Central Ontario Regiment from service under the Military Service Act, 4; York and Simcoe Foresters, 3; Army Service Corps, Engineers, 12th Forestry Depot, Military Police, A. D. C., and 67th Battery, each one.

Excise officers visited the canteen of the Royal Canadian Dragoons, Stanley Barracks at the week-end and confiscated the tobacco stock which included several hundred thousand cigarettes. Tobacco sold at military canteens is distributed at lower rates than in the general market. It is alleged that some of the soldiers buying at this canteen allowed civilians to also benefit. The government is determined to increase the revenue in this respect by increasing the price of tobacco at soldier rates.

Full Supply in Sight Atlantic Sugar Refineries Announces Reduction in Prices. An interesting announcement is made in another column which will do much to alleviate the present anxiety of the public in regard to sugar. The Atlantic Sugar Refineries, Ltd., whose estimates of the market in 1917 have proved reliable to date, believing in the gradual decline in price of sugar during the ensuing three months, have today marked down all grades of their sugar 10c per 100 pounds.

The company's refinery has worked at a steady gain throughout the year, and the firm is confident that sufficient of the raw material is available to supply the normal Canadian requirements, provided the public takes the normal course of buying sparingly until the new crop is available.

Soldier Dies Suddenly. John Watkins Lived Only an Hour After Reaching Hospital. Taken suddenly ill in a rooming house at 10 Grosvenor street yesterday afternoon, John Watkins was removed to the General Hospital, where he died one hour later. Watkins is a returned soldier, and when the attending nurse found him in the house was attracted by the soldier's condition. Police Officer Hyndman was called in and ordered his removal to the hospital. The body will be taken to the morgue and an inquest opened this afternoon.

Loading Stolen Apples. Charged with theft of apples from a Grand Trunk freight train, Timothy McCarthy, 30 years of age, was taken to a railway policeman, McCarthy, the police say, was ignorant of the fact that the apples were stolen. He said that he intended leaving the city for Montreal, when a man approached him and offered him a job to load the apples from the train on to the wagon.

Negligence Caused Death. That Arthur Maynard came to his death as the result of being struck by a trolley car through his own neglect, was the verdict of Coroner Young's jury at the morgue last night. Maynard, a returned soldier, was struck by a Bloor car at the corner of Bloor and Jarvis streets on October 28 while riding a motorcycle.
