The Rector thus writes to the Society:

"I am pleased to find that our contribution exceeds that of last year 18 per cent., although it is nothing in comparison to what it ought to be, what the people are able to give, and what gratitude (setting aside for the moment higher considerations) demanded of them. When the D. C. S. first began its labors of love there was in this Mission but one Church and about sixty Communicants; here are now, partly through its instrumentality, within the same bounds, four substantial Churches. The Mission has been divided. Barrington has had and will again have a Missionary largely supported by your Committee. In my own immediate Mission there are 112 Communicants, and during the last year I baptized 87 children. One of my country Churches is filled every other Lord's Day with a congregation of *Churchmen*, and in the other we have a congregation of almost every name, of from 50 to 100, or even 120. In one of these Churches may be seen, on Communion occasions, from 25 to 30 Communicants humbly kneeling around the Lord's Table, partaking of His most precious body and blood, who, but for the aid of your Society, would perhaps never have had, or not for a long time, the blessings brought within their reach. O yes, we ought to be grateful for what, by the blessing of God, the D. C. S. has done for this Parish. I pray that we may be led to show our gratitude not by words but by deeds, and that, if we shall be spared to see another year, our offering may be increased not 18, but 100 per cent. That the Divine blessing may rest upon the Society, is ever the fervent prayer of one who has been a member from its very beginning."
