The Synod took up a reference from the Presbytery of King- Mr. Wightman  
ston, respecting an irregularity in the removal of Mr. Thomas of Camden.  
Wightman from the charge of Camden to the Toronto Academy.  
The Synod having considered the case, agreed to express their  
disapprobation of the irregularity that had been committed, in  
not duly recognising the Presbytery of the bounds in Mr. Wight-  
man's resignation of his charge, and instruct the Presbytery to  
accept his resignation and release him from the charge of  
Camden. The Synod also agreed that Mr. Wightman should be  
attached to the Presbytery of Toronto as a Minister without a  
charge.

The Synod agreed to instruct the College Committee to prepare Licensing  
a draft of regulations respecting the Licensing of Students, and Students.  
submit the same to the next meeting of Synod.

The Synod being unable to overtake several matters reported Business
