London, Jan. 17.—In the entire history of the great war few events have so profoundly aroused public opinion in Great Britain as what is now known as "the War Office Petticoat scandal," in which Mrs. Cornwallis-West, a member of the aristocracy and a princess and one of the leading social figures in Great Britain, has played a part of unusual interest. Reports of the findings of the official court of inquiry have already been carried to New York, but the letters of Mrs. Cornwallis-West furnished further interesting details of the case.

Interested in Wounded Soldiers

After being in hospital for some time, he was sent to Bryneclyn, the home of Mr. and Mrs. Birch at St. Asaph, Denbighshire, which had been generously converted by Mr. Birch into a convalescent home for wounded soldiers. That was in February, 1915, Barrett being a sergeant. He remained at Bryneclyn through the summer and autumn of 1915, and, as in other establishments for wounded soldiers, there were of course many other soldiers, Mrs. West saw Barrett, and it was in him that she took most interest. Such interest, incidentally, some time in the autumn she suggested to Barrett that he ought to be held commissioned rank. Owing to her representation a commission was obtained, and on this matter there is no criticism, as the court of inquiry found that Mr. Barrett was in every way suitable for the promotion.

Early in February, 1916, he visited Ruthin Castle, the home of Mr. and Mrs. Cornwallis-West, and here he met the first of these visits. Barrett was carried up stairs and down in an invalid chair. A few days after his second visit to the castle, Lieut. Barrett received a letter from Mrs. West in which she said:

"If by any chance you are writing to that dear boy (Lieut. Barrett himself) we were talking about, you give him my love and tell him I often think of him."
