

SHOT AS SPY

von Tirpitz, recent resident member of the New York Yacht Club who has been in an English detention camp was

The other was as persistently reported as Hans Adam von Wedel, who, like Rintelin, was a principal figure in an aleged plot to obtain fradulently an American passport to carry information to the German government.

Rintelin, with Edward Meloy, a mining promoter of 55 Liberty street, was indicted by the Federal Grand Jury on the charge of conspiracy to defraud the United States government in obtaining a passport. Meloy is out on \$10,000 bail. The federal authorities were silent on the whole Rintelin-Meloy matter by order from Washington.

The execution of Rintelin and von Wedel, if it be a fact, interpreted as meaning that the British government has determined to deal with German secret agents against its interests in this country as if their acts had been committed in British territory.

More startling was a story which reached officials here that the German, who also attained high social rank here, had documents of such importance that an offer of \$50,000 for permission to reproduce them had been made. There was a strong intimation that the state department has full information of the nature of the documents Rintelin is said to have carried and it was intimated that the indictment of Rintelin and Meloy is a small phase of a matter which the fedgral grand jury will continue to investigate.

PRISON TERM FOR CHAUFFFUR

Dover, N. H., Oct 22-Leo P. Maloney. George Rossborough, of Prince William, York, N. B.; Murray J. Fogarty, Windsor, N. S.; Charles M. McJunkin and Duncan J. Grey, both of St. John, all members of the 26th Battalion, have been reported wounded in France. Major W. R. Brown has been admitted to hospital. George McDonald, Fredericton, 9th Battalion, has been reported seriously ill, and John C. Hartley, Scotland, appears as the first casualty in the Divisional Ammunition Column, under Lieut. Col. Harrison. He is reported wounded.

Cajt Leon H. Currey, son of Senator Curry, of the Rhodes, Curry Co., Amherst, N. S., has been killed in action in France.

Pte. James Murphy, a young Irishman, who fought with the Princess Patricias in France and lost a leg early in February, is in the city on his way to Sussex to visit his brother, who is in the 64th Battalion. He belongs to Armagh, Ireland. An effort is being made to get him work here.
