



WASHINGTON WILL NOT HAMPER LOANS TO BELLIGERENTS

Belief That Credit Funds Will Lead to Purchases of Big Supplies.

Washington, Oct. 80-Viewing credit transactions, the Washington administration will not attempt to interpose its influence against such transactions on the part of American bankers.

This was learned on the highest authority today after it became known that German financiers were contemplating the establishment of a credit loan in this country similar to the \$10,000,000 credit fund negotiated by the National City Bank of New York and other bankers for the French government. for the French government.

The decision of the Washington administration may lead to the purchase in the United States of about \$50,000,000 worth of supplies by Russia, and an equal if not a greater amount by Germany. Details of the expected transactions are lacking here.
