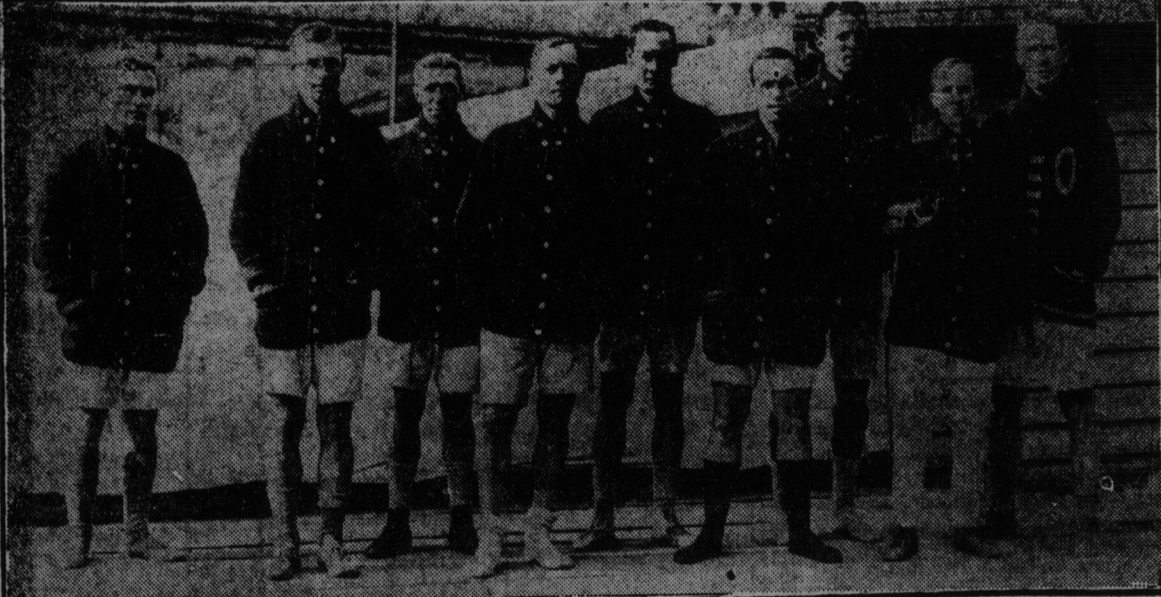


MAGDALEN COLLEGE CREW WIN GRAND CHALLENGE CUP
