Caughnawaga, 22^d Feb. 1895.
Evidence ^{in favour} of Jacques Lachandiere.

Nichel Jacob, aged 64 years,
duly sworn, declares and says:-

I know the parties in this case. I know the matter in which they are concerned. I know the land in dispute. I know that the land in dispute belonged to the late Pierre Montour; it was he that worked it. I do not know how long ago it was that this land belonged to the late Pierre Montour, but it was about twenty years ago. Before that time I always believed, as I heard I had heard, that the land belonged to the Parkins family; but when I saw Montour working there, I believed that it was his. To the best of my recollection the late Montour worked on this land during two summers; he cut away the underbrush; the land had not been sown before that.
