I know the matta in which they are concerned. Akum the land in dispute. Know that the land in dispute belonged to the late Viene Montour; it was he that worked it. I do not know how long ago it was that this land belonged to the late Perre Montour, but it was about twenty years ago. Defore that time Aslivays believed, as shound Shad heard, that the land belonged to the tacking family; but when Som monton working there, I believed that it was his to the best of may recollection the late Scontour worked on this land during two summers; he cut away the underlaush the land hadnot been sorn bysettet.
