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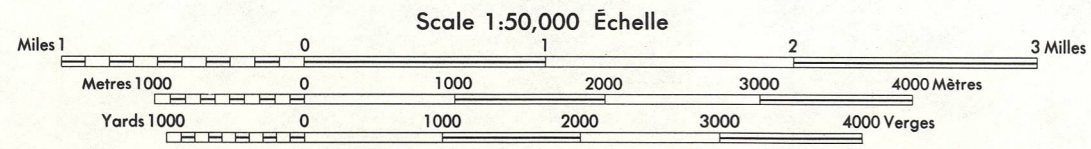

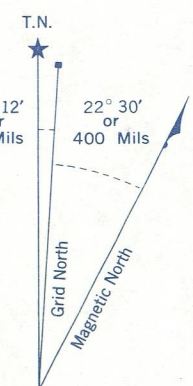
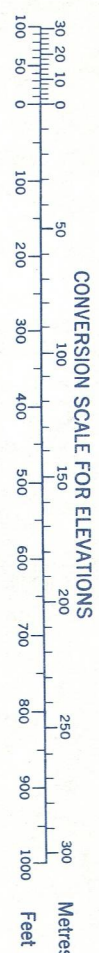

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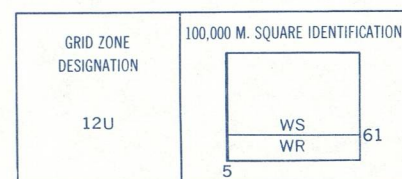

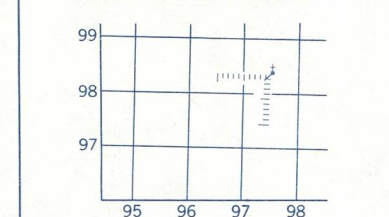

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED  
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES



REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (as above)

EASTING: Read number on grid line  
immediately to left of point  
Estimated tenth of a square from  
this line eastward to point 975

NORTHING: Read number on grid line  
immediately below point  
Estimated tenth of a square from  
this line northward to point 984

EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 975844

Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
