PARIS, Aug. 1. Nancy and Belfort were evacuated yesterday by the German troops, who burnt all their goods which could not be carried off. The inhabitants of both cities remained in their houses while the Germans were leaving.

BALTIMORE, Aug. 1. HANCOCK and HALLOWAY, the murderers of Mrs. LAMPY, were executed at five minutes to ten o'clock this forenoon. Nicholas had a final farewell interview with his wife and children, father, mother, brothers and sisters, yesterday, which was of a most affecting character.

OTTAWA, Aug. 2. In consequence of the arbitrary rules of the Typographical Union Ottawa publishers, except the proprietors of the Times, have passed resolutions deciding to employ whom they please. The resolutions do not interfere with wages or hours of labor.

LONDON, Aug. 1. The bill granting £25,000 per annum to the Duke of Edinburgh came up today for a third reading. Sir Charles Dilke made a long speech against the grant. Mr. Gladstone replied with bitterness, characterizing the present opposition to the bill as indecent. After further debate the bill was passed in Committee.

NEW YORK, Aug. 2. There was a collision on the Hudson River railroad, between Irvington and Tarrytown, yesterday, in which a passenger train and a freight train were wrecked and many persons injured, and it is feared fatally.
