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Refuse To Pay Tax Until Roadway Has Been Repaired

Property Owners of Chester Street Up in Arms—Declare They Will Enter Lawsuit If Necessary, and Demand That Work Done Be Condemned.

ST. THOMAS, Feb. 24.—The property owners of Chester street, through G. R. McKenzie, notified the board of works that they will not pay the frontage tax charged to their holdings until the roadway is placed in proper repair. The residents declare that they will stand for a lawsuit rather than contribute a cent of taxes for the work on the street.

Mr. McKenzie presented a petition by practically every taxpayer on the highway, protesting against the alleged improvements, and demanded that what has been done there now be condemned and the residents will then sign a fresh petition for the construction of a proper and permanent roadway.

KITCHENER MEN OPPOSE RADIALS
Mayor Fears Doubling of City Debt If Radial Debentures Are Added.

TORONTO, Feb. 24.—Witnesses who were to have been called to give evidence this afternoon at the inquiry being conducted by a royal commission into the practicability of the Ontario Hydro-Electric Power Commission's radial railway projects had an appointment with Premier Drury, so the commission adjourned until tomorrow morning. R. S. Robertson, counsel for the municipalities opposed to the railway schemes explained that they were the witnesses, and in view of their wishing to interview the premier he had thought they should not be called to testify until afterwards. Mr. Robertson did not state who the witnesses were. Kitchener sent a delegation to the commission, and most of them gave evidence before the commission this morning.

John Lane Turner, Kitchener, thought the town was well served by the G. T. and Grand River Railway, both of which had sidings to the factories. Geo. Luppatt, chairman of the Kitchener Light Commission, said he could not complain of the service now given, although he agreed that accommodation would be appreciated if the rates and the service were an improvement.

Mayor Chisholm gave Kitchener's tax rate as 30 1/2 mills, with the debenture debt at \$1,455,000. If the radial debentures were included, this debt would be doubled, he said.

Ald. E. C. Graves of St. Catharines was another radical opponent.

TEACHERS ARE PAID THEIR BACK SALARY
Trouble Threatened at Point Edward Has Been Settled.

SARNIA, Feb. 24.—The educational crisis which threatened the village of Point Edward has been averted. A. C. Truesler, principal of the school, stated in an interview tonight that the teachers have received their salaries for January. Treasurer T. A. Morris of the board received the necessary funds from Treasurer W. McClester. The payment of salaries, which has been allowed to slip since the first of the year, is the means of retaining the scholars in the school and preventing the teachers from taking the leave of absence which the board had decided to grant them if the money had not been forthcoming today.

It is the opinion of Secretary D. J. McMurrie that the teachers will be able to get along until the school year is over. The teachers' union, however, has expressed their June examinations, and the financial question so arranged that matters will be conducted on a salary basis the rest of the year. The teachers are not pleased at the delay in the money as they had no desire to leave the school. The money not arrived their financial status would not have warranted their staying on at the school.
