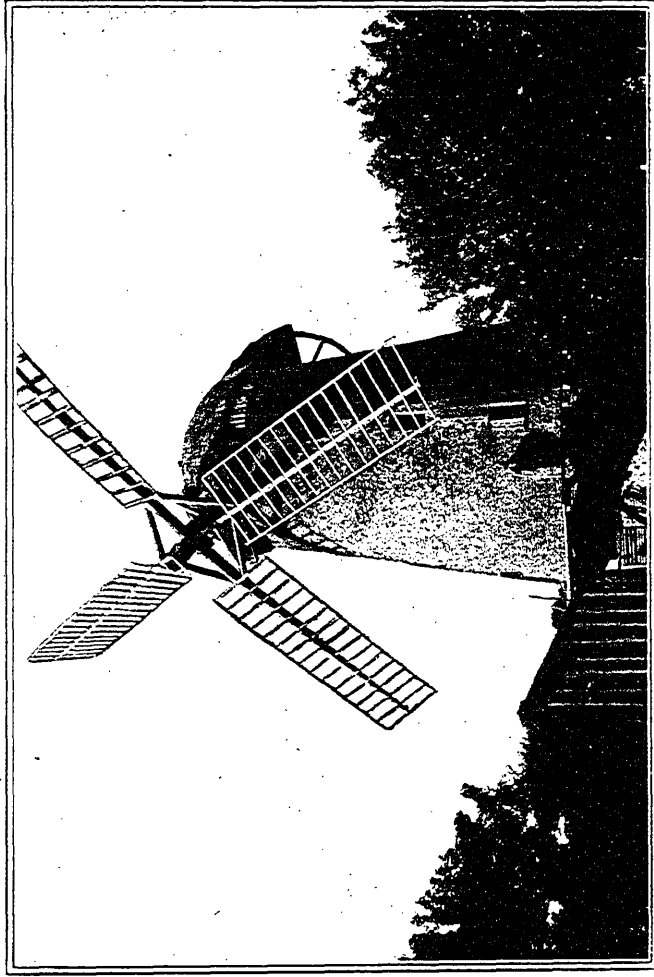




The Old Windmill on the Lachine Road.
