With reference to the new plan of your right of way through the Pasqua Indian reserve, it is noted that these plans now show the distance from the N.E. corner of Sec. 24, Tp. 20, R. 15, W. 2.M., to a post planted on the easterly limit of your right of way to be 391.2 feet and a distance of 57.5 feet from that post to the centre line, which makes the total distance from the N.E. corner of Sec. 24 to the centre line, 448.7 feet.

When these plans were previously submitted, the distance from the N.E. corner of Sec. 24 to the centre line was taken to be 391.2 feet, as indicated in Departmental letters of the 10th March last and the 11th ultimo. Kindly inform me if the plans are correct which show 391.2 feet as being the distance from the N.E. corner of Sec. 24 to the easterly limit of your right of way.
