Relatives and friends of the pupils of course 100 were invited to attend. W/C W.G. Welstead, the Commanding Officer, presented the wings to the graduates and Commander R. Thomassen of the Royal Norwegian Air Force presented the flying badges to the Norwegian graduates of Course 100. Personnel formed up on the Sports Field in three squadrons at 1530 hours where they were sized. From there they marched to the parade square and formed up in a hollow square independently Following the ceremony refreshments were served to the personnel of the wings party and their relatives and friends. There were 62 graduates in all: 33 R.C.A.F., 13 R.A.F., 9 R.A.A.F. and 7 R.N.A.F. The wastage on the course was 7 R.C.A.F., 6 R.A.F., 3 R.A.A.F., which makes a total of 16.
