On two occasions the matter of giving a grant for the salary of the teacher who conducts the school at the Roman Catholic Mission at Norway House has been brought before the Department.

The Department would like to have a full report from you on the work that is being carried on by the Roman Catholics at this point. You should state the number of Catholic Indians and children of school age permanently located and if a building has been erected by the Church you should give full particulars with respect to it. Any other information that will enable the Department to intelligently consider this matter will be gladly received. Be good enough to give this matter your early attention.
