
Ottawa, June 25, 1917.

Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 21st instant, I beg to say that Mrs. Francis Pheasant, of Cockburn Island, Band, may be allowed to take up lot 26, Con. 18, township of Robinson, and \$50 will be allowed her and Isaac Pheasant for the purchase of lumber and material for building houses on these lots, accounts to be forwarded to the Department.

The Department will also allow \$50 to be expended on road extending from the road built last year to lot 44 from the east, the road to be built on concession between 17 and 18, and as far as lots 26, and the accounts may be furnished in the usual way.
