Sir,-

I beg to advise you that the loan of \$2,500 to Jonas Noah of the Moravian Reserve has been granted.

I observe that this man is to take over the land and implements purchased for Frank Noah whose loan has been cancelled, and I have written the Indian Agent accordingly. The amount paid for the implements and land will, therefore, be charged to Jonas Noah, and in addition you are hereby authorized to make the following expenditure: \$350.00 for a team of horses; \$65.00 for a set of work harness; \$60.00 for feed and \$100.00 for repairs to the barn.

I do not see on file the deeds for the purchase of the North part of lot 35 and lot 38. If you have not already secured these you should do so immediately and forward them to Headquarters. Kindly advise Agent Beattie of any action you desire him to take.
