To seek to advance the interests of Canada abroad as at home, realizing at the same time that our interests are increasingly bound up with those of our associates in the British Commonwealth of Nations, our good North American neighbour, and all countries, whether linked in the League of Nations or co-operating through other channels, which are prepared to work together for the establishment of peace.
2. To build up the national defences to meet in adequate and responsible measure any probable danger of attack.
3. To strive, in the conduct of our own affairs and in our co-operation with others, to understand the needs and ways of thought of other peoples while maintaining our own needs and our own ways of life, and by such understanding to aid, within the measure of our capacity, in the restoration of confidence, the acceptance of peaceful methods of adjusting difficulties, and the liberation of the world's energies for the opportunities of advancing prosperity and new security which have been made available.
