

Paw-ala, on Coal or Call Creek, there was apparently room for a reserve on the northern bank of the river immediately above T.L. No. 11130, and he recommended that 10 acres be granted. The herrings came in there in quantity and the place was also good for shrimps and prawns. The application for an extension of the Etsokin Reserve he would not recommend, as he thought these Indians had all the land they reasonably required at that point. With respect to Giltum, he was of the opinion that all the land asked for had been alienated, being now under T.L. No. 8036. He recommended, however, that forty acres be granted, as the land was fairly good, such 40 acres to be north of and adjoining the reserve No. 2. This would take in the village site referred to in No. 7 application. The application for an addition to Na-un-kak-danis, which was the Indian name for Reserve No. 2, he would not recommend as the land applied for had been alienated. This was also included in No. 6 application. As for Kusan or Meosa: All the land asked for was under timber limit or Crown Grant and the application therefore could not be endorsed. The same conditions applied with respect to Lagikilila, this place being covered by old Crown Grants. The lands asked for at Giliagilise, at the head of Cutter Creek were in unreasonable quantity for the use of the Indians applicants, but he recommended that a fishing station of 10 acres be granted at the head of Cutter Creek, the salt water bay as described on the Admiralty chart, the recommended location being at the mouth of the Creek falling into that bay. The bay should more properly be known as Cutter Creek Bay and the stream as Cutter Creek. To get the 10 acres recommended it would be necessary to take in both sides of the stream. The Mahmagulesala and Xaxawadulalis applications could not be endorsed, the land in each case having been alienated. At Kwatsas he recommended that 10 acres be granted and also the small island opposite, of probably half an acre. At Hanatua
