

and direct that they and their successors, duly elected and appointed, shall continue in the said offices until such time as a warrant shall be granted to their said lodge, under the seal of the Grand Lodge of England.

And for so doing this dispensation shall be their sufficient authority, to remain in force until such warrant shall have been granted, but subject always to the approval of the Most Worshipful Grand Master. And the said lodge shall be called No. 1, and in addition to the said number, to assume the name of St. Andrew's Lodge.

Given under my hand and seal at York, in the said Province, this 24th day of September, in the year of our Lord, 1822, and of Masonry, 5822.
