In this beautiful and highly ornamental volume the borders are by Berain, Coypel, and Le Clerc, the portraits on the medals are by Edelinck, and the reverses by Audran and Picart. Page 35, we notice, has been neatly repaired and within the first cover will be found the ex-libris *Arma Jacobi Christiani Clementis Bell et Jane Strangman Acad uxoris ejus*. The volume also contains the fine old Medal *KEBECA LIBERATA MDCXC*.
