aforesaid; who are severally to account to the House of Assembly for their respective expenditures.

II. And be it further enacted, That all the aforesaid sums of money shall be paid by the Treasurer by warrant issued by the Lieut. Governor's LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF Commander in Chief for the time Warrant on the being, by and with the advice and consent of His MAJESTY'S Treasurer. Council, and the receipts of the several persons entitled to the Receipts to be infaid sums, indersed on the said warrants, shall be to the Tree dorsed on the Warfaid sums, indorsed on the said warrants, shall be to the Trea-rants, furer good vouchers and discharges for so much as shall thereby be acknowledged to be received. The faid fums to be paid as monies may come into the Treasury, after the several sums are paid off, directed to be paid in and by an Act made and passed during the present Session, intituled " an Act for ap-" propriating certain monies for defraying the expences of the "Province."
