

C A P. XXXIII.

AN ACT to facilitate the execution of the Act of the fifty seventh George the Third, Chapter thirteen, inasmuch as it relates to the appointment of Commissioners for the improvement of the Navigation of the River Richelieu and to appropriate a sum of Money therein mentioned for that purpose.

29th March, 1826. Presented for His Majesty's Assent, and reserved "for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure thereon."

14th March, 1827. Assented to by His Majesty, in His Privy Council.

29th August, 1827. The Royal Assent signified by the Proclamation of His Excellency the Governor in Chief.

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make further Legislative provision to carry into effect the purposes of the Act of the fifty seventh year of the Reign of His Majesty George the Third, Chapter thirteen, as far as the same relates to the improvement of the Navigation of the River Richelieu, between Sorel and Fort Chambly, for which object the Sum of Fifteen hundred and fifty pounds Currency was by the said Act appropriated, and to make a further appropriation towards improving the Navigation of the aforesaid River:—Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly, of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America*;" "and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said sum of Fifteen hundred and fifty pounds Currency appropriated by the aforesaid Act passed in the fifty seventh year of the Reign of His late Majesty George the Third, intituled, "An Act to make more effectual provision for the improvement of the Internal Communications of this Province," towards the Navigation of the River Richelieu between Sorel and Fort Chambly, or such part of the said sum as may at the time of the passing of this Act remain unexpended, shall be applied for the aforesaid purpose and as provided by the said Act under the superintendence
