HEREAS it would very much encourage and promote the cultivation of Hemp in this Province, if some provision was made by the Legislature for the purchale and exportation thereof; in order therefore to make provision for fo beneficial an object, as far as the prefent refources of the Province will admit, We your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Commons of Upper Canada, in Parliament affembled, do most humbly befeech your Majesty that it be enacted, and best enacted by the King's most excellent Majelty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act paffed in
