A KEEN DEMAND FOR HAY TODAY

The Supply Was Small—Brisk Selling Is Looked for on Thursday.

MEAT PRICES UNCHANGED

Beef Is Firm—Apples Are About Off the Market—The Quotations Today.

Prices were lacking around the market this morning. There was very little doing in any line, and consequently no change in prices.

It is expected that there will be a keen demand for hay tomorrow. In fact, the demand existed today, but the supply was unable to satisfy it. There were only six loads of hay this morning and they went rapidly from \$11 to \$12 a ton. Some farmers have already to get away from the market, stating that he had 30 loads to come. Two loads of straw sold at \$7 a ton. Four loads of oats were offered, and sold from \$1.17 to \$1.20 a cwt.

Meat Prices.—There was little change in meat prices this morning. Dressed pork is selling from \$11.50 to \$12 a cwt. One dealer stated that he expected a big supply tomorrow, as many farmers will be killing today.

Yesterday's unprecedented prices for dressed beef stood firm today, and a continuance is looked for. \$11 a cwt. is still the price. Apples are about done. This is the situation the apple dealers find themselves in against. However, they are registering no kick. They have had a good long season and feel about satisfied.
