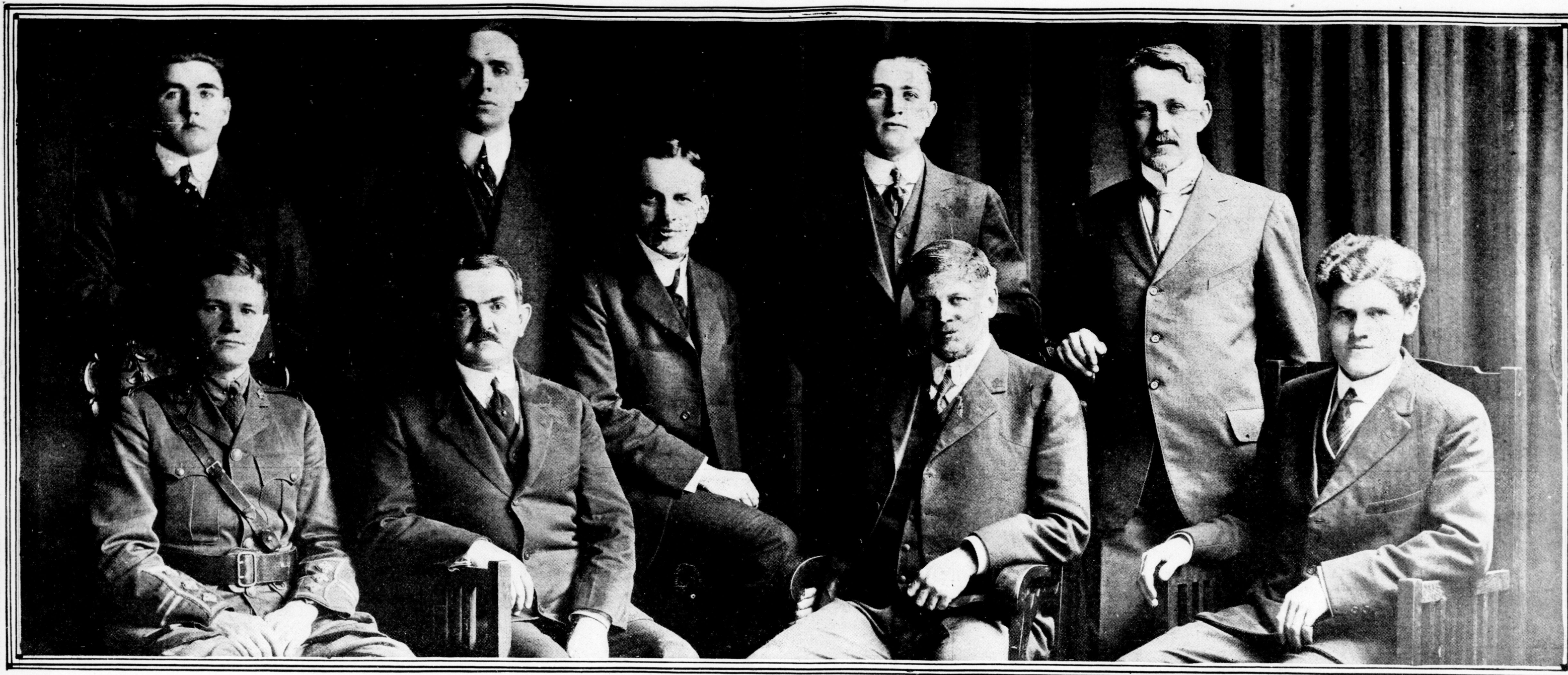
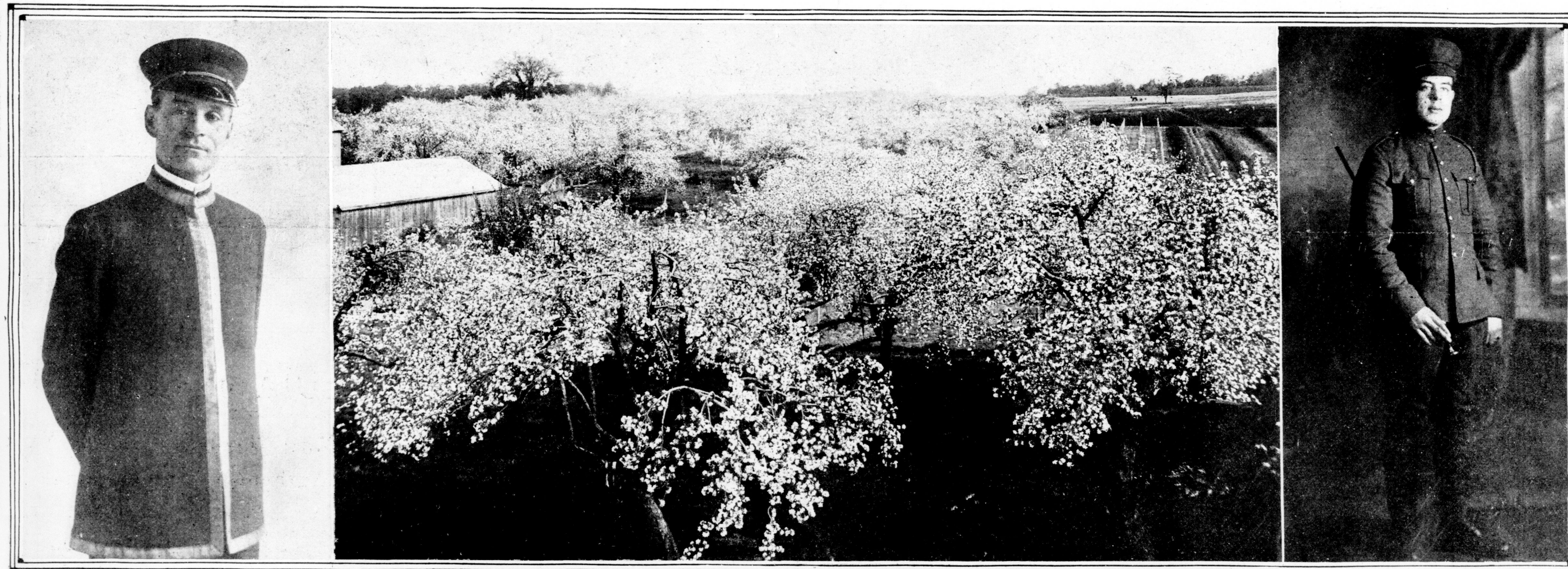

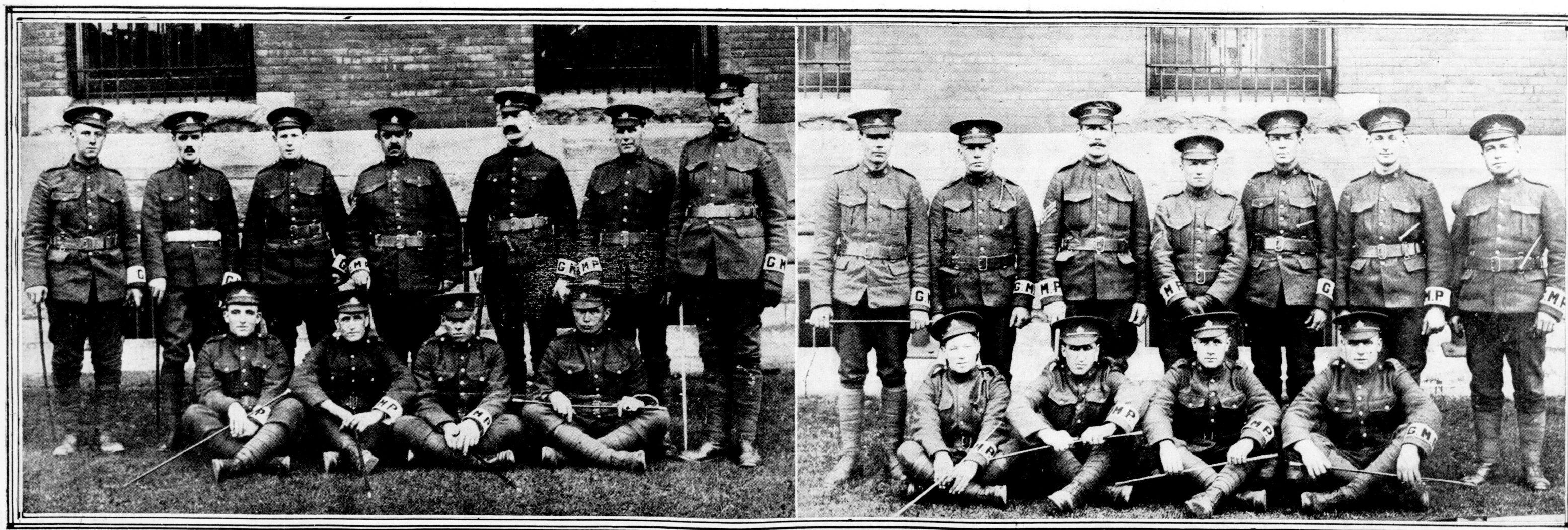
Who for the past season has been one of the staff of the Princess Winter Garden. He made many friends for that place of amusement.
