Progrefs of the War.

On the 22d of July the City of Mayence, garrifoned by 12,000 French, furrendered to the arms of his Pruffian Majefty. The principal articles of Capitulation, that the Garrifon march out with the honours of war, carrying with them their arms, baggage, and other effects the private property of individuals, on condition that they do not ferve, during the space of a year, against the allied Powers.

On the 28th of July, the Garrison of Valenciennes surrendered to his Royal Highness the Duke of York; The conditions, that they were to march out with the honours of war, afterward lay down their arms, retire into the interior of France, and not serve again against the allied powers during the war.

Advices from England of the 15th of August mention that the Queen of France was then under trial at Paris, and that Custine had been tried and beheaded.

Admiral Howe's fleet was returned into Torbay.

Last advices from the United states mention that a malignant fever raged at Philadelphia, which had carried off great numbers of the inhabitants.
