This report is a summary of the Trade and Industrial Development Program activities and results which were submitted by the diplomatic missions abroad during the period covered in four separate quarterly reports.

The program's primary objective is to assist in the economic development of the world. Since it is not possible to attempt to compare, for example, the state of the world with those of Dallas, and though each mission has its own trade program position, nevertheless there is a common objective that comparison with a geographic region is necessary. Graphical presentation of the data is provided to assist the reader to scan the data and results and results within individual regions.
