

The two parties will encourage contacts among representatives from Canadian universities and research institutes, and representatives from the National Research Council, the Institute for the Italian Encyclopedia, the Giorgio Cini Foundation, the Querini Stampalia Foundation of Venice, the Giovanni Agnelli Foundation of Turin, and other Italian academic institutions.

The two parties will promote the educational and cultural undertakings sponsored by the Committees of the Dante Alighieri Societies operating in Ottawa, Montreal, Quebec, Edmonton, Hamilton and Winnipeg.

Article 9. Each year, the two parties will organize an exchange of at least four university professors, researchers or academics for visits lasting not more than fourteen days in order to take part in seminars, symposia and conventions and to give lectures.

For said exchange, each party will allocate a maximum of 56 days to the other party.

Article 10. The two parties note with satisfaction that the first session of the seminar series on "Relations between Italy and Canada through Italian documents" was held in Ottawa, March, 1991, with the participation of Italian and Canadian academics. They also expressed the wish that the series continue.

The two parties also note that the following events may be held in Rome:

- Symposium entitled "Global Change" with contributions by experts from both countries on issues of environmental change;
- Symposium on the "Cultural Presence of Rome in Canada" possibly with an art exhibit on the topic organized by the Canadian party;
- Symposium on "The Role of Universities in Research Policy".
- Symposium on "Universities and Regional Research and Development in Italy and Canada"
