

Service interest in establishing exchange activities in order to enrich and broaden the research base critical to the "Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village Provincial Historic Site", an Alberta Culture project that seeks through various means to present the story of the settlement of east central Alberta between the 1890s and 1930s.
