PRAYERS.

The following Notice of Motion having been called was transferred to Government Orders for consideration at the next sitting of the House pursuant to Standing Order 21(2):

That the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections be empowered to study the Canada Elections Act and the Report and Evidence of the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections 1959, and to report to the House such proposals as the Committee may deem it to be advisable.—*The Acting Secretary of State.*

The following Questions were made Orders for Returns under the provisions of Standing Order 39(5):

*Question No. 46, by Mr. Pickersgill,—Order of the House for a Return showing: 1. Has there been an increase in federal payments to the provincial governments between the fiscal years 1956-57 and 1958-59 and, if so, how much?

2. How much of such increase is attributable to (a) legislation enacted before June 21, 1957; (b) legislation enacted since June 21, 1957?

3. Is any portion of this amount for the federal share of hospital insurance and, if so, how much?

Question No. 192, by Mr. Fisher,—Order of the House for a Return showing: 1. Has the government ordered and received aircraft designated as the CF-100?

2. If so, when was the first delivery received and what has been the delivery figures by month since then?
