possible to legislate for companies rather than attempt to follow the incidence of the legislation into the account books and finally into the estates of various people who may or may not become shareholders as they think proper.

Mr. DUPRE: I move that after the word "transfers" in the fourth line there be inserted the words "or in a branch register of transfers."

Amendment agreed to.

Mr. GEARY: Has the attention of the minister been drawn to line 21 on page 21, in subsection 2? Is it proposed to have the same amendment here? Does the same alternative apply after the word "transfers"?

Mr. CAHAN: Yes.

Mr. DUPRE: I move that subsection 2 be amended similarly in line 21.

Amendment agreed to.

Section as amended agreed to.

Section 37 agreed to.

Mr. BUTCHER: Will the minister allow sections 38 and 39 to stand.

Mr. CAHAN: Yes.

Sections 38 and 39 stand.

Mr. CAHAN: As this is a convenient place and it is a few minutes to eleven o'clock I move that the committee rise, report progress and ask leave to sit again.

Progress reported.

At eleven o'clock the house adjourned, without question put, pursuant to standing order.
