Mariners:—House went into Committee to consider a Resolution relative to "An Act respecting the treatment and relief of Sick and Distressed Mariners, etc.;" Resolution adopted; reported and agreed to and Bill (No. 129) presented: Mr. McLelan, 428. Read second time; considered in Committee; reported; read third time; passed, 506. Passed by the Senate, 588. Royal Assent, 639.—47 Victoria, Chapter 21.

Maritime Bank of the Dominion of Canada:

1. Petition for an Act empowering them to reduce their Capital Stock, etc., 105. Report of Notice, 137. Bill (No. 66) presented: Mr. Wood (Westmoreland), 139. Read second time and referred to Committee on Banking, etc., 148. Reported amended, 436. Considered in Committee; reported; read third time; passed, 454. Passed by the Senate with amendments; concurred in, 528. Royal Assent, 639.—47 Victoria, Chapter 47.

House went into Committee to consider a Resolution respecting "The Seamen's Act 1873," and the Act respecting Certificates to Masters and Mates; Resolution adopted; reported; agreed to and Bill (No. 116) to amend "An Act respecting Certificates to Masters and Mates of Ships," and "The Seamen's Act," presented: Mr. McLelan, 326. Read second time, 414. Considered in Committee; amended; reported; agreed to, 428. Read third time; passed, 442. Passed by the Senate, 516. Royal Assent, 639.—47 Victoria, Chapter 19.
2. Order—Return respecting each individual who has received a Certificate of either Competency or Service under the Act passed last Session making provision for the Examination of Masters and Mates of Coasters and Inland Waters, etc.: Mr. Baker (Victoria), 275.
