

STANDING RULES
FOR THE
CONSTITUTION AND GOVERNMENT
OF THE
Newfoundland Church Society.

I.—This Society shall be called "THE NEWFOUNDLAND CHURCH SOCIETY."

II.—The Officers of this Society shall consist of a Patron, a President, Vice-Presidents, a Treasurer and Secretary. The Committee of Management shall consist of the Officers of the Society, and of Seventeen Lay Members, of whom four shall be elected by Members of the Society resident in the Deanery of Avalon; three by Members resident in the Deanery of Conception Bay; three by Members resident in the Deanery of Trinity Bay; three by Members resident in the Deanery of Notre-Dame Bay; two by Members resident in the Deanery of Placentia Bay; and two by Members resident in the Deanery of Fortune Bay, of whom seven shall be quorum. The election of the Lay Members of the Committee shall be as follows:—On Easter Tuesday in the year 1855, and on Easter Tuesday in every succeeding fourth year, a meeting of Electors resident in each Deanery shall be convened by the Senior Clergyman (or, in the
