SYNOPSIS OF DOMINION LAND REGULATIONS.

Any person who is the sole head of a family or single male over 18 years may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made by a brother, sister, brother-in-law, mother, father, or other person of intending homesteader.

Persons residing upon the land for cultivation of the land in each of 3 years. A homesteader may live on a minimum of at least 80 acres, or on a larger tract of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, or brother or sister, in certain districts a homesteader in the possession of a 160 acre quarter section alongside his homestead. Homesteaders must reside upon the home-
