

WILL NOT SUPPLY WATER TO TOWNSHIP

York Township Council Bill Turned Down in the Legislature.

STANDS OVER A YEAR

Mayor Will Call Conference to Formulate Plans for Solution.

York township council was defeated in its effort to gain powers from the legislature to force the City of Toronto to supply the township with water by the decision of the private bills committee of the legislature on a close vote of eleven to ten yesterday.

Reeve Syne headed a large delegation from the township to urge the compulsory supplying of water and was confronted by Mayor Hocken, Controller McCarthy, Ald. McBride, Commissioner Harris, and Corporation Counsel Geary, who asked for a year's delay.

Will Call Meeting. Mayor Hocken promised, at the matter was held over, to have a meeting of the city and township representatives to consider the formulation of a feasible plan.

WANT COMMISSION TO CONTROL RACING

Government, However, Does Not Think Innovation is Necessary.

A very determined fight was put up by A. C. Pratt of South Norfolk, for the appointment of a racing commission, which would do away with the justices now alleged to exist at meetings where the "poor public" comes and lays down money in the hope of getting returns and invariably is defeated.

Mr. Pratt quoted the results of parliamentary elections and said that at some Ontario meets the passage of money daily was in the region of \$100,000.

Mr. Pratt stated that he could not find the demand spoken of and that things were going on very well. In the few years there have been a wonderful turnover for the better. The matter should be laid aside for the year.


Opening of the Season—Springtime at the Springs.
