QUESTION—What Ministers are recommended for Superannuation?

On motion, the cases of Revs. Geo. Hartley, Thos. Voaden, Charles Stringfellow and R. J. Forman were referred to the Committee on Conference Relations.

On motion, the cases of several superannuated ministers, whose names were forwarded to the President by the Treasurer of the Superannuation Fund, for special review by the Conference, under paragraphs 408 and 409 of the Discipline, were referred to the Committee on Conference Relations.

QUESTION 4—Are there any objections or charges preferred against any of our Ministers or Probationers?

Resolved,—That we regret the circumstances that have caused our beloved brother, Rev. Dr. Orme, to decide it to be in his own interest to resign his membership in our Conference. We recognize in him an able minister of the Gospel, a true brother, and a faithful servant of the Master. We assure him of our continued interest and brotherly regard for him, and will pray that God's blessing may attend him through life.
