to anfwer by my adverfaries, and the Sentence and warrant of commitment which they gave. By which it will appear that I am the only evidence examined to difcover any matter they might turn to my difadvantage, and they made themfelves, at fame time, Judges and parties.

I am induced to take this mode to remove imposition, that has been practifed on the public in various artful shapes to bewilder and divert their enquiries from the truth concerning me, about which much pains has been taken and by other oppression, than my confinement, endeavours to compell me by fervile acquiescence to yield up the right and Liberty of my fellow Citizens.

I had wrote the foregoing when Mr. Young the keeper of the Common prifon addreffed me in a fet of words that I could not comprehend any meaning from, except fomething doubtful, whether or not what he faid was to be confidered as a meflage from the Sheriff EDWARD WILLIAM GRAY Efqr. who I wrote to for certain information, if it fhould pleafe him to favor me therewith in writing, to which he gave my fervant (as he fays) an angry verbal antwer. That his *Mofter* knew very well what Mr. Young meant, and there was
