

SITUATION IN EUROPE WEAKENS THE MARKET

Heavy Selling in Final Hour Cancels Gains and Substitutes Losses in Many Cases—Domestic Developments Over Week-End Are Conflicting.

New York, March 7.—During the first half of today's stock market session technical considerations prompted extensive covering by shorts, but this condition was largely reversed later, when cables from London indicated a rupture in the intensely negotiable.

Heavy selling occurred in the last hour, canceling previous gains of one to three points, and effecting many losses of like points. Liquidation for both accounts and for the general public was moderate, however, on news that the allied forces had received orders to invade Germany.
