Woodbridge—Vaughan township. A village situated on the river Humber, and a station on the Toronto Grey and Bruce Railway. This village was laid out by the late Roland Burr, Esq., about 1835. F. J. Bunt, Esq., and Captain Nathaniel Wallace were amongst the first settlers. The *Woodbridge Works*, for the manufacture of agricultural implements, carried on by Mr. John Abell, are the largest in the county. Woodbridge contains two excellent general stores, Messrs. Roe & Bro., and Messrs. Wallace Bros., both of whom do an excellent business. The former (Roe & Bro.), do a business little short of \$100,000 per annum. Messrs. Roe & Bro. also carry on large woollen mills, which give employment to a large number of hands. Population about 600.
